Both a professional mountain bike and cyclocross athlete, she boasts an impressive record, including second place finishes at the U23 World Cup in Mont St. Anne in 2022 and at the U23 Cyclocross World Cup, in Waterloo, 2023.

Munro grew up downhill ski racing, and transitioned to cycling at the age of 14. She's currently finishing up her last semester at Colorado Mesa where she's studying Cellular, Molecular, and Developmental Biology. After graduation, she will focus full time on racing. After racing, she aspires to go to Physicians Assistant School and work in the medical field, a passion of hers outside cycling.

As part of Ride for Trek Factory Racing, Munro has her sights on an Olympic berth and a Mountain Bike World Championship title.

As a mentor for Voice in Sport, Munro motivates women and girls to get into sports and pursue academics, working to create opportunities for young girls while also advocating and inspiring the next generation.

With a popular social media following, Munro relates to the younger generation. She's also heavily involved with youth activities and events.

She says, "I speak well to any audience, I can be a positive and engaging speaker and face for brands or sponsors. I have been to USA Cycling Events with their main donors, talking and speaking in front of the group. I have been a part of regional and local NICA events, participating in group rides and activities at these races with the kids."

She's also a board member for the Pro Cyclist Foundation (PCF) where I work as a young female pro with insight into USA Cycling, UCI Mountain biking and collegiate cycling.

Munro says, "Outside of winning medals and jerseys, the biggest thing for me is giving back to the sport. I want to bring up the next generation of riders, girls especially."
